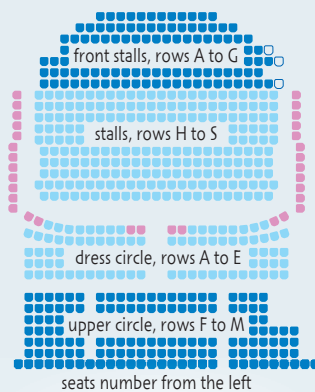

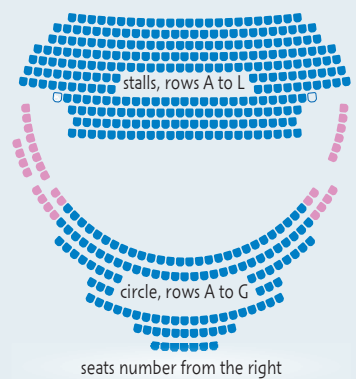
Seating Plans
